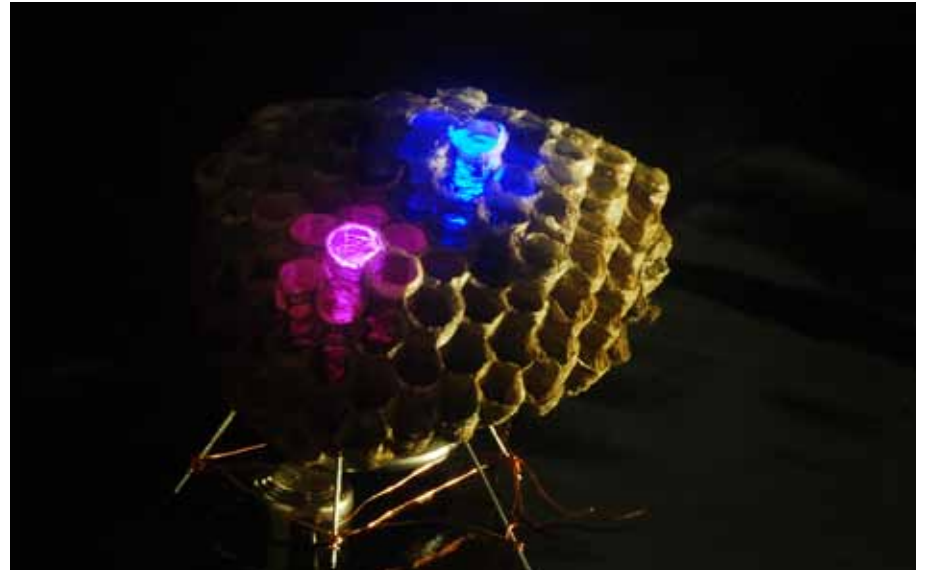
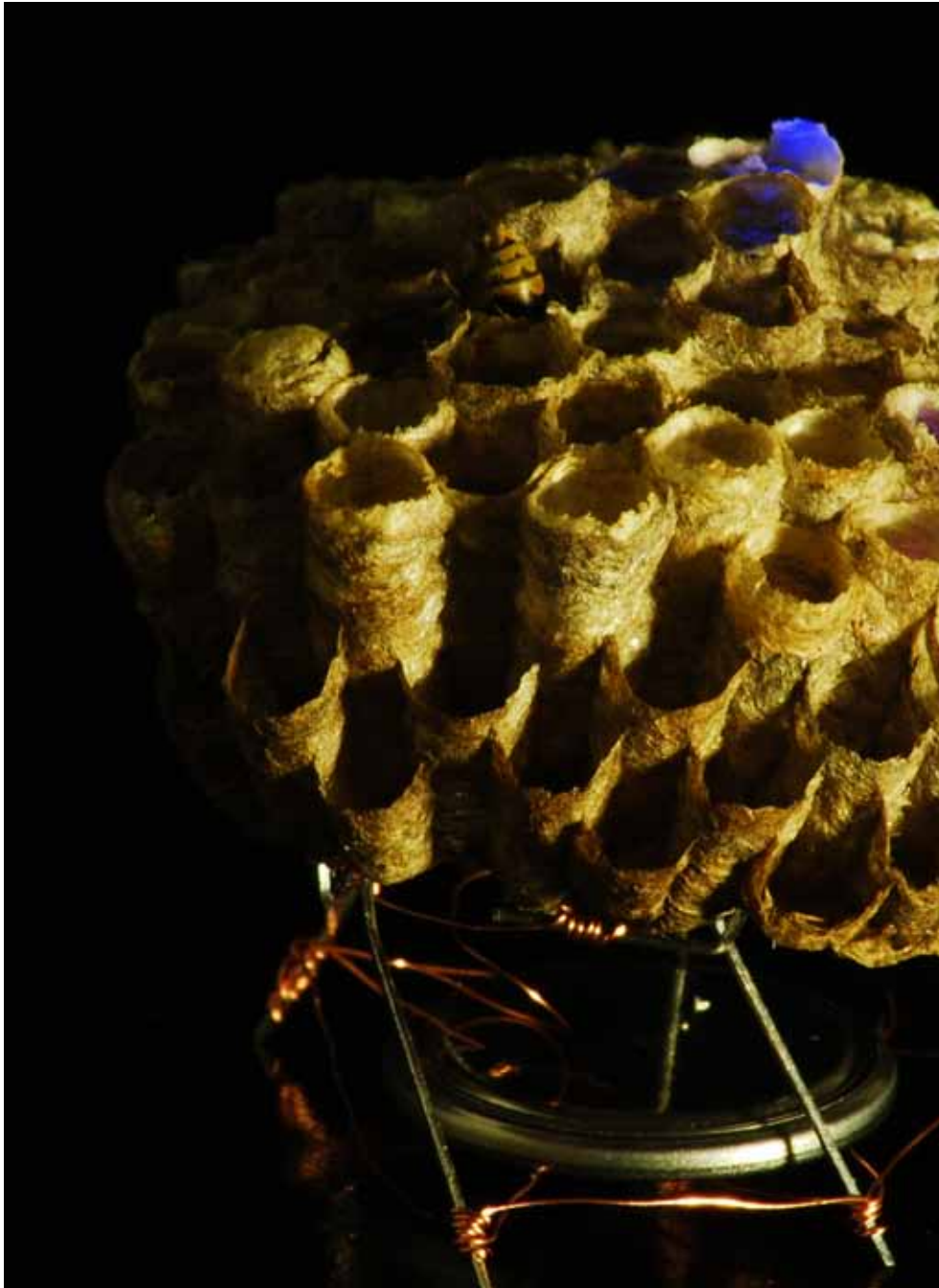
81 hard drives operate simultaneously on a 5 channel system. The reading needles vibrate to produce sound.

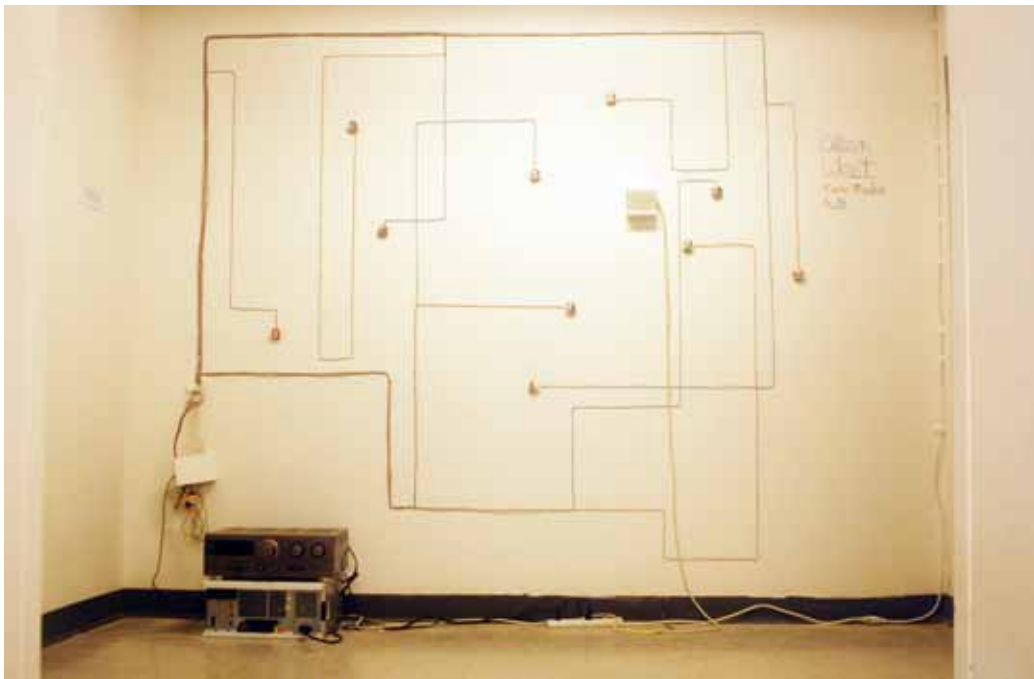
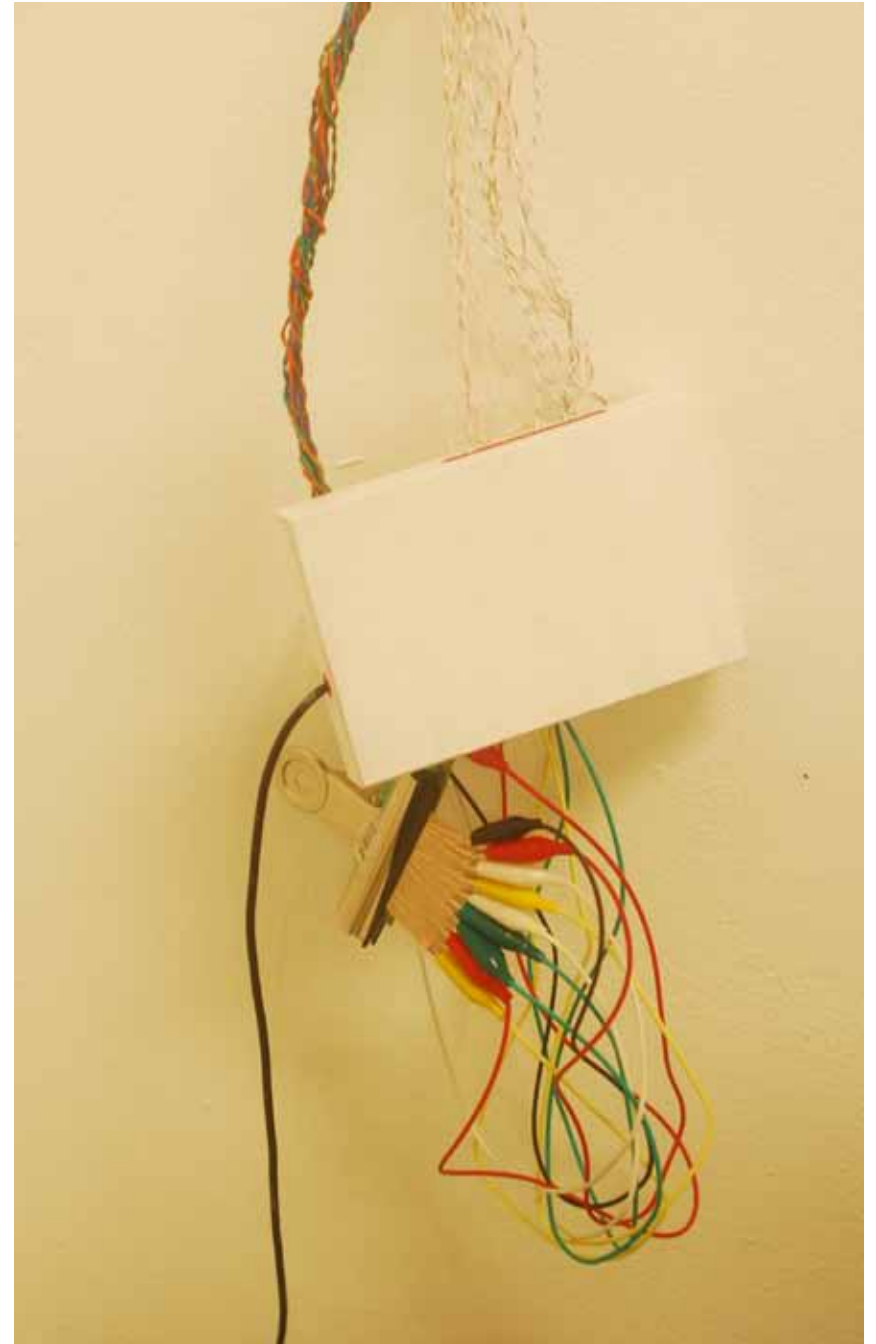
1940's style dress translates motion into resistance that causes the light to dim, brighten, and flicker.

October, 2009

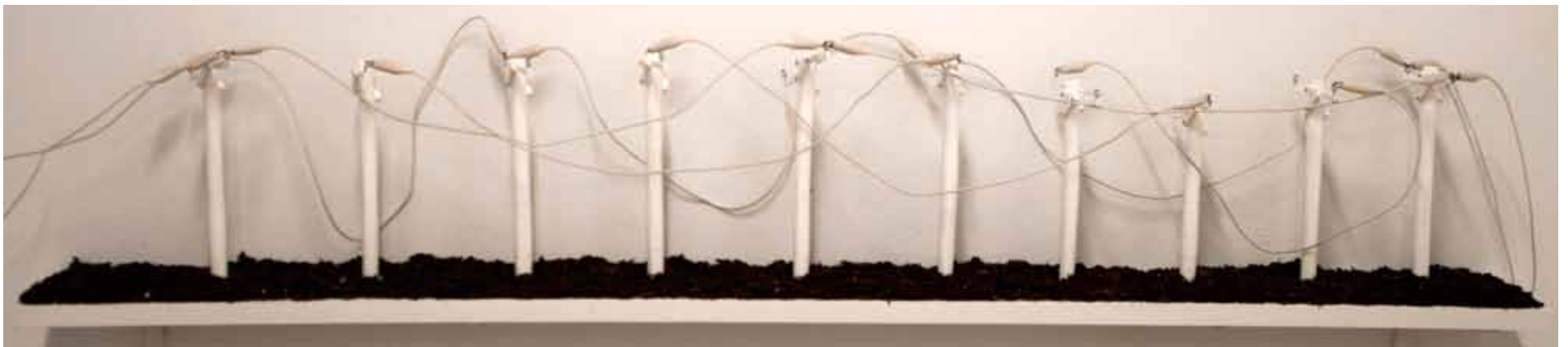
A sight specific installation on Peaks Island. Participants walked down a runway that changed the pattern of lit halogen bulbs as the walked.

November, 2009

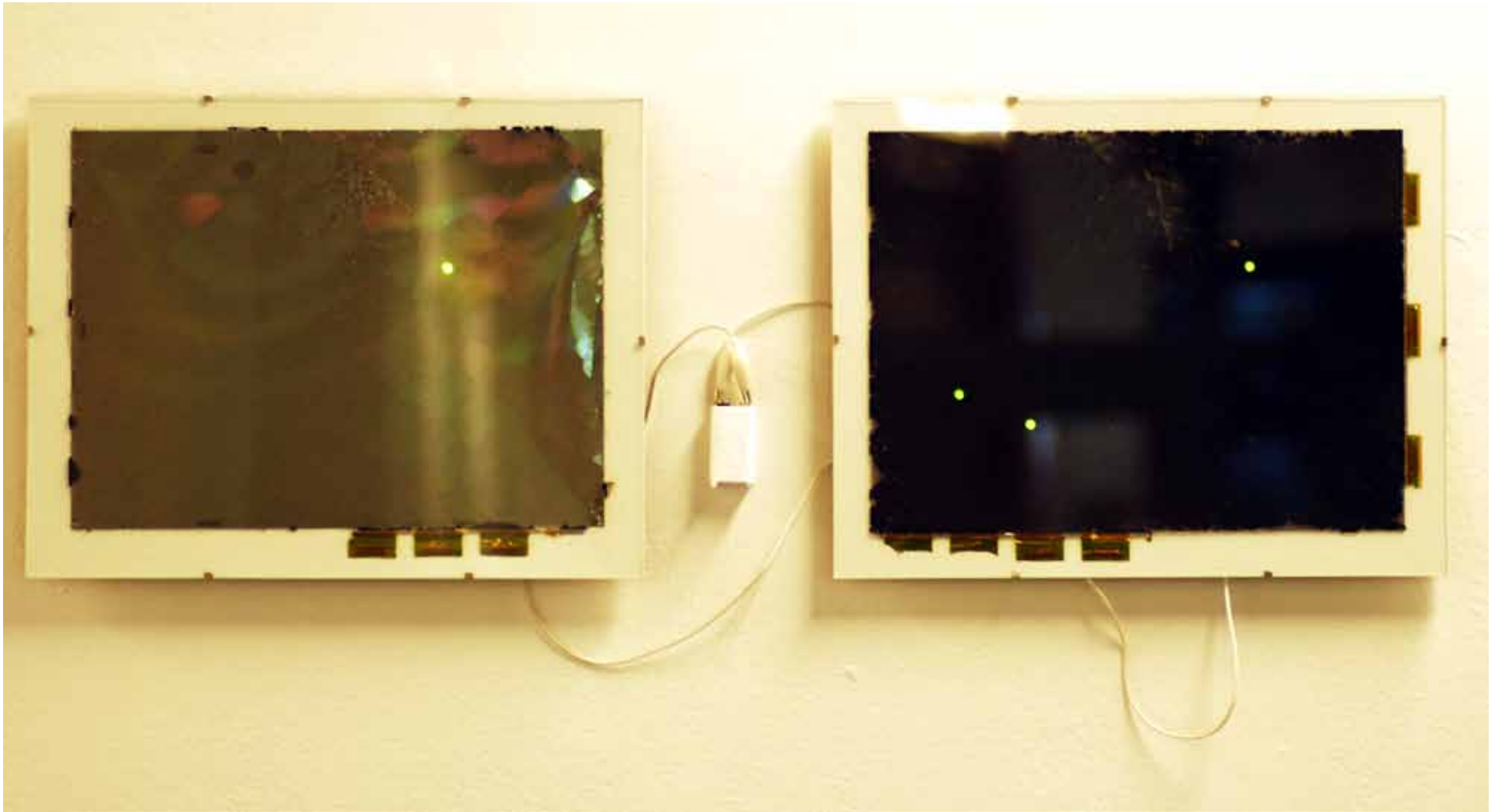
Each carpet triggers the light to its left. As a result three people are required to illuminate everyone.

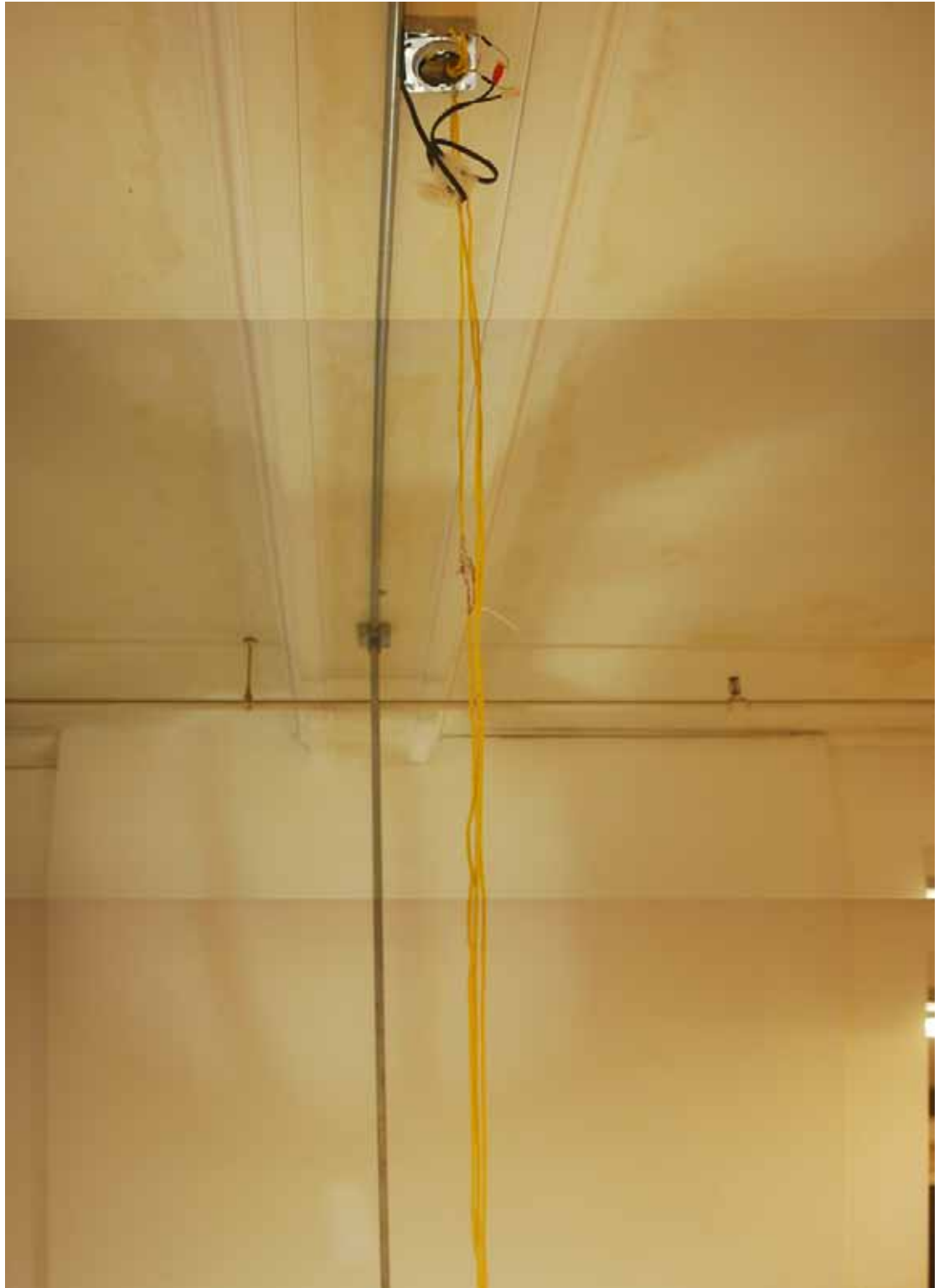

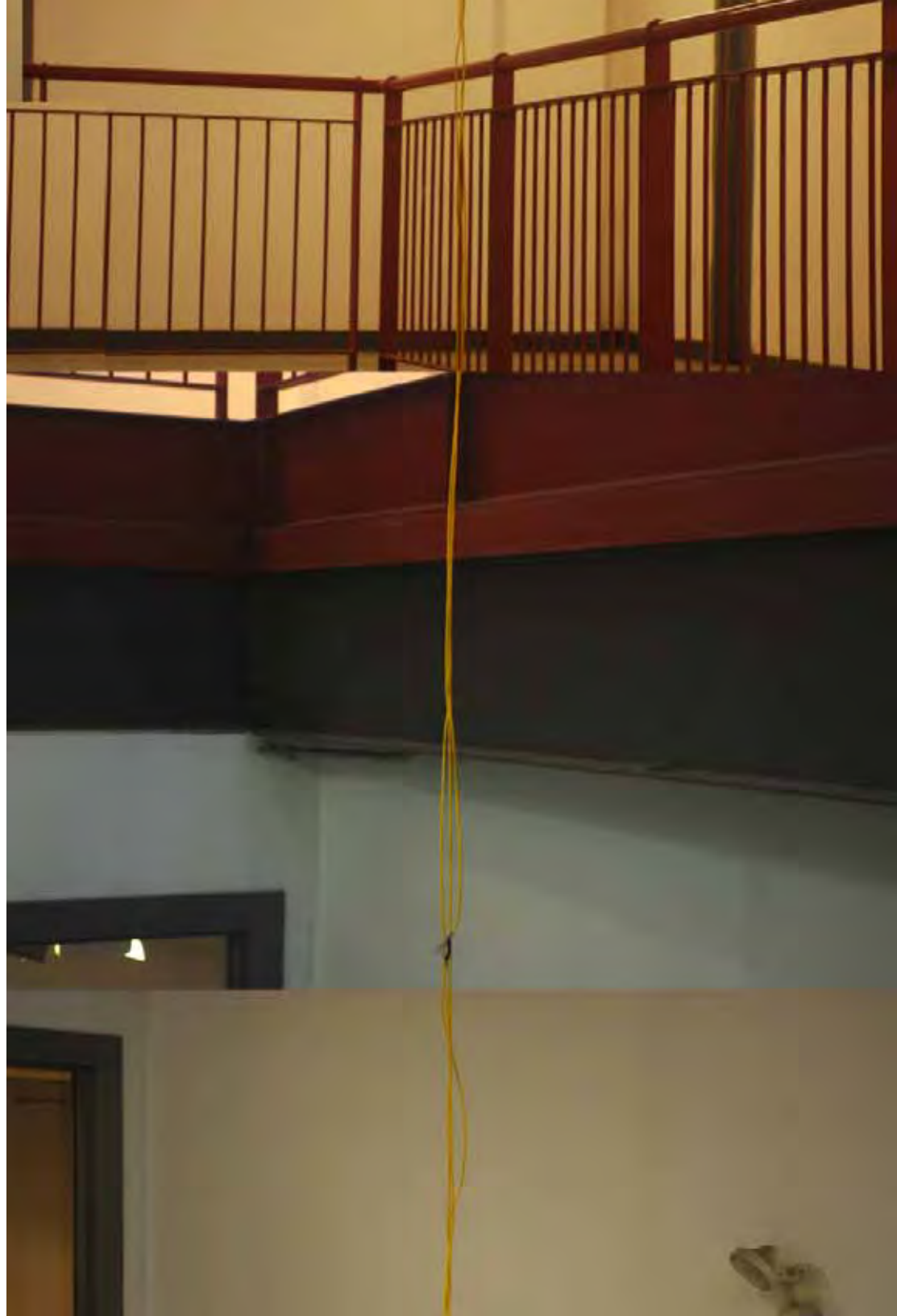
The small musical instrument alters sound in response to contact with human skin.

January, 2009

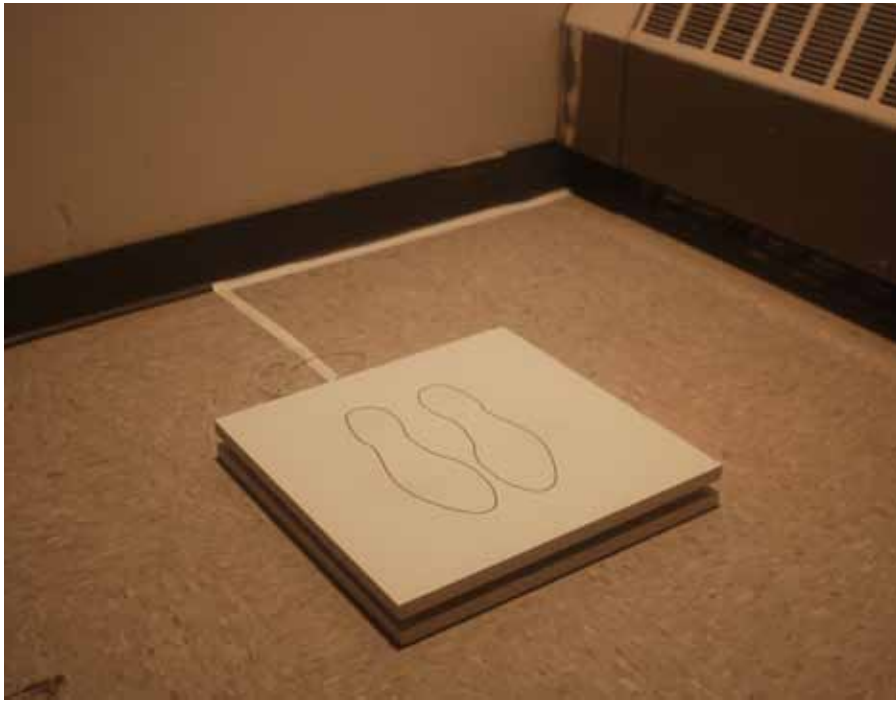
Audio compositions of recorded electrical noises plays quietly so that the audience must place their head close to the piece in order to hear it clearly.

November, 2008

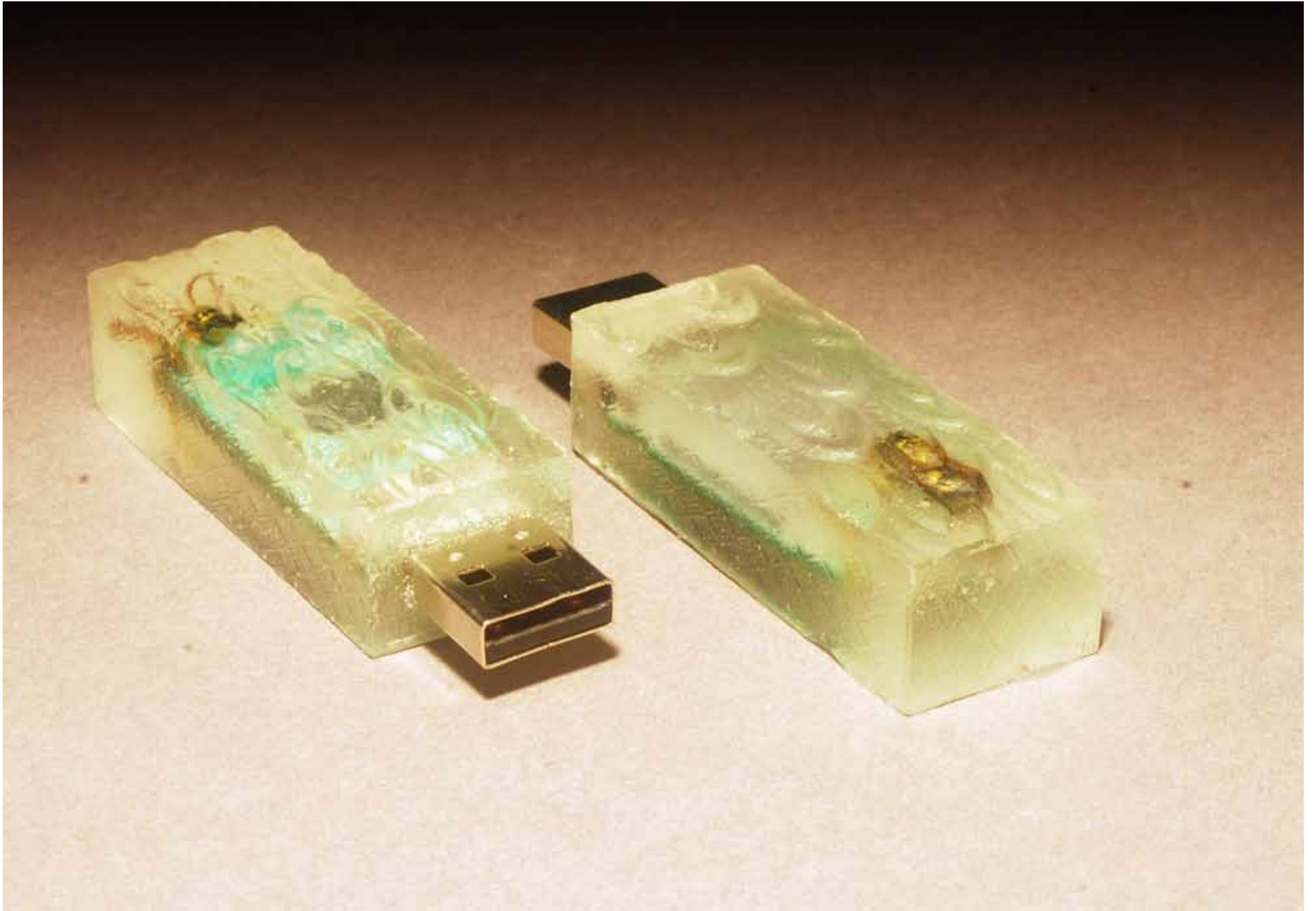
Participants are invited to sit and have their consciousness altered by composed bi-nuaral sounds.
